Lidl's Wine Tour – April 2025

With apologies, this is a little later than usual......and, much though I like to think that the wines in today's new Wine Tour are selling well, I hope that this is not so late that you will miss them! I am confident you won't......

Whites

Orvieto Classico - £6.99 – One of Italy's most famous dry whites – reliable, not too heavy, most refreshing and highly moreish

Viognier Terre Siciliane - £7.49 – If you are looking for a white with a little more richness of flavour and a tad less dry, this is for you. Interesting Sicilian take on the tasty Viognier grape.

Greco di Tufo - £8.99 – Classy Italian dry white from Campania vineyards inland from Naples. Quite full-bodied, herb-scented and an excellent food wine.

Junge Winzer Pinot Blanc- £8.99 (£7.99 for Lidl Plus members) – Yet another reminder that German wine is seldom sweet these days! Lovely, light, refreshing dry white.

Reds

Albali Gran Reserva - £7.99 – One of Spain's best selling and most famous wines, Viña Albali always hits the spot. Now fully mature, retaining freshness and vibrancy.

Duca di Sasseta Nero di Troia - £7.49 – From one of southern Italy's most exciting grapes, Nero di Troia – fragrant, flavoursome, good depth of flavour.

Passamano Frappato Syrah - £6.99 – An Italian blend of characterful grapes – relatively sweet for a red, smooth, flavoursome, probably rather good with the barbecue.

Sparkling

Flaureo Prosecco Rosé - £7.99 – Prosecco is highly popular and so is rosé......so you can't go wrong!
