Greco di Tufo is an exciting white grape from Campania, the rugged volcanic vineyards inland from Naples, and it's refined, dry, well worth a try. This example shows scented, herbaceous and fresh pear characters, for a white wine with good body. Dry and uplifting, try a glass of this with grilled prawns, white fish or lobster, or a herby fennel risotto.

Chiante Riserva



Italians are justifiably proud of Chianti, often the perfect accompaniment to Italian food. An authentic example, this wine boasts a mature flavour. With notes of fruitcake and sweet spice, it is dry with a balsamic finish. Superb served with spaghetti bolognese or lasagne.
