

Hello and welcome to the new Lidl Wine Tour which will be in store from Thursday January 21st. I realise that many of the wines below will be unfamiliar names but, if you wonder where the real value lies in the wine world at present, it is hard to look beyond Spain and, particularly, Portugal. Even if you are taking your wine drinking easy at the start of 2021, I would urge you to buy a bottle or three of these wines for future needs!

### White Wines

- **Encostas de Caíz Avesso Vinho Verde, Portugal** - £6.49 - More body than a typical Vinho Verde and with less fizz - beautiful, almost ethereal wine, so refreshing.
- **Paço de Bispo Palmela, Portugal** - £6.99 - A regular at Lidl in recent years and simply back by popular demand - light, dry and effortlessly drinkable.
- **Rosário Viosinho Casa Ermelinda Freitas, Portugal** - £6.99 - Never heard of the Viosinho grape before? Me neither! But this is another delicious Portuguese dry white.
- **Salneval Albariño Rias Baixas, Spain** - £7.99 - Really fine, mouthwatering Albariño at an excellent price for this quality level.
- **CEO Godello Monterrei, Spain** - £8.49 - Another one you may recognise from last year. From the same part of Spain as the Albariño - different grape, but similar, beautifully balanced result.

### Rosé

- **Cabriz Dão Rosado, Portugal** - £6.99 - When judging wines, the temptation is to be swayed by concentration of flavour. This is the opposite - light, delicate and supremely refined rosé. Just off-dry.

### Red Wines

- **Monsarraz Reserva Alentejo, Portugal** - £6.99 - From some of Portugal's most beautiful vineyards, inland from Lisbon, excellent dry red made from local grapes.
- **Torre de Ferro Dão Reserva, Portugal** - £7.49 - Exciting to find this level of complexity at this price point - matured in the cellars so that it is perfect to drink now.
- **Entre Quintas Douro Reserva, Portugal** - £6.99 - Full-bodied red that will suit those who like that note of smokiness that comes from oak ageing.
- **Agramont Old Vine Garnacha, Spain** - £7.99 - Juicy, fruit-driven style, with the old vines giving that extra depth of flavour. Excellent example of modern Spanish red.
- **Hachón Ribera del Duero Reserva, Spain** - £8.99 - Impressive, oak-aged red from one of the top red wine regions in Spain. Perfect with steak or the Sunday roast.
- **Eje Monastrell Alicante, Spain** - £7.49 - Rich, warming winter red - good depth of fruit, backed up by pleasing spicy notes.
